- Organise technical visits in cooperation with e.g. Young PIANC;
- Delegate a Young CEDA representative to each of the CEDA Commissions/Committees to assist and allow for a direct input of Young CEDA ideas and suggestions within the Commissions and Committees.

I expect 2010 to be a busy year in which we will be setting up and organizing the above mentioned activities.
